Directions To Point Reyes Station's Firehouse And Meeting Room

Fourth & B Streets

From the North:

As you enter the town of Point Reyes Station, you are on B Street. Continue on B Street to Fourth. No need to curve into the commercial district.

From the South:

As you enter the town of Point Reyes Station on Hwy 1, turn left on the first full street after crossing the bridge, Fourth Street. Follow approximately 2 blocks to the corner of Fourth & B.

Or, you can drive along the main street of town, and at the T turn left and go one block.

Look for big red trucks.

Directions to the meeting room:

Go through the double doors on B Street and the meeting room is approximately 10 feet directly ahead. You have to push the button on the door to open, not simply pull on the handle.

Directions To Point Reyes National Seashore Association Building

At the entrance to Point Reyes National Seashore in Olema, follow the signs to the Bear Valley Visitor Center past the first set of offices and park buildings.

The visitor Center is a very large brown barn-like building (not the Red Barn!).

Please Park in the lots behind the visitor center.

Walk through the parking lots to the south and take a right before the Bear Valley Trail head up the hill to the Morgan Horse Farm buildings.

The meeting is in the first white farmhouse with the large hedge around it.
