# Update: GFNMS Climate Action Plan

**March 2016**: Council reviewed, discussed, voted to approve 76 of the 84 strategies developed by the Climate-Smart Adaptation Working Group

**March – November 2016**: Climate Action Plan developed with 24 of those recommended strategies

**November 2016**: Climate Action Plan and final recommendations presented to Council, along with next steps for implementation

- Implement Living Shorelines (LS -1,2,3)
- Protect and Restore Habitat (H-1, 3)
- Science Needs (SN-2,3)
