Dear Greater Farallones National Marine Sanctuary Advisory Council Applicant:

We are in the process of filling vacant seats on our sanctuary advisory council. Beginning immediately, we will accept applications and nominations for council membership.

The Greater Farallones National Marine Sanctuary Advisory Council was established pursuant to Federal law to ensure continued public participation in the management of the sanctuary. Specifically, the council's role is to provide advice on: (1) protecting sanctuary wildlife and habitats, and identifying and evaluating emergent or critical issues involving sanctuary ecosystems and cultural resources; (2) identifying and realizing the sanctuary's research objectives; (3) identifying and realizing educational opportunities to increase the public knowledge and stewardship of the sanctuary environment; and (4) assisting to develop an informed constituency to increase awareness and understanding of the purpose and value of the sanctuary and NOAA's Office of National Marine Sanctuaries (ONMS).

Please note that if you have been a federally registered lobbyist in the two-year period before your potential appointment date to the council, you will not be eligible to serve as a member of a sanctuary advisory council.
