FROM SAN FRANCISCO

From US 101 South, continue on CA-1 and follow Sloat Blvd, CA-35/Skyline Blvd and Great Highway exit to the San Francisco Zoo and Botanical Gardens.

FROM THE EAST BAY

Take Highway 80 W and merge onto US 101 and take the exit to merge onto 280 S. Take exit for John Daly Blvd toward Junipero Serra Blvd and continue on John Daly Blvd. Turn right onto CA 35 and use the middle lane to turn left onto Great Highway exit and then take the exit toward Zoo parking at the San Francisco Zoo and Botanical Gardens.

FROM PETALUMA

From US 101 S, use the right two lanes to follow CA-1 S towards 19th Ave/Golden Gate Park. Turn right onto Sloat Blvd, slight left onto CA-35/Skyline Blvd, then turn right onto Great Hwy exit toward Zoo parking at the San Francisco Zoo and Botanical Gardens.
